REGISTERED OFFICE & AML COMPLIANCE NEW OBLIGATIONS FOR COMPANIES

Effective October 1st, 2026

The Swiss Federal Council is strengthening corporate transparency and compliance requirements in Switzerland

WHAT IS CHANGING

BENEFICIAL OWNERS (BOs)

Companies concerned will be required to identify, verify and document the individuals who ultimately control them, and comply with the new reporting obligations.

NEW AML OBLIGATIONS

Certain activities related the incorporation, management, or structuring of companies, the provision of registered office services and certain real estate transactions, may now fall within the scope of Swiss anti-money laundering (AML) legislation.

WHY TAKE ACTION?

Incomplete, inaccurate or outdated information, or failure to comply with the applicable deadlines, can lead to administrative measures and sanctions.
